



The Ceremonial is a great place to learn about Native American culture.



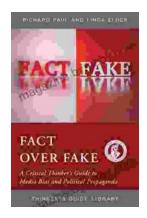
