- Size 11 seed beads in your desired colors
- Size 12 seed beads in gold or silver
- Beading thread
- Beading needle
- Scissors
- Optional: bead stopper

Beading Techniques

Before we begin, let's review a few basic beading techniques that you will need to know.

Peyote Stitch: The peyote stitch is a simple beading technique that is used to create 3D shapes.
