

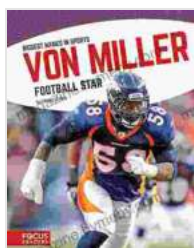
Von Miller: The NFL Superstar Who Defied the Odds

a dominant force for the Broncos, earning three Pro Bowl selections and two All-Pro selections.

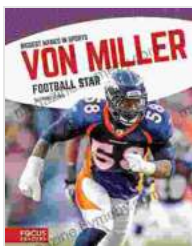
